Background of TDDAP2

Tackling Deadly Diseases in Africa Programme Phase II (TDDAP2) is a £19M FCDO investment that aims to contribute to the reduction of harmful impacts from infectious disease threats in African populations and globally. The overall intended outcome is to strengthen regional and national public health and emergency capability in Africa to prevent, detect and respond to disease outbreaks.

Palladium has been awarded the National and Community Technical Assistance Component, the overall outcome is to strengthen national public health and emergency capability to better prevent, detect and respond to disease outcomes in Ghana, Uganda, DRC, Kenya and Malawi and contribute to the following impact: 'Reduced harmful impacts from infectious disease threats in African populations and globally'.

It is expected that consultants to be admitted to the pool will have a minimum of 5 years professional experience relevant to their field. A master's degree in the relevant field is desirable.

Your application should be sent to the contact email by the closing date and time and should include the TA Expert Questionnaire (Appendix 1) compiled with attached CV (maximum 4 pages), Due Diligence questionnaire compiled and copy of an identification document.

Admission in the TA Pool

The admission in the TA Pool will follow these steps:

1. All the applications are reviewed and evaluated based on the level of expertise of the applicant against the thematic areas. Experts that meet the minimum criteria move to the next step. Experts that are unsuccessful are notified.
2. Due diligence is conducted on the experts. Once the due diligence is completed without red flags, experts move to the next step.
3. Experts are admitted to the TA Pool, and they are eligible to apply to Mini Competitions for TDDAP2 programme.
